Dear Friends and Partners,

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord! Debbie and I thank God for you everyday. We deeply appreciate your prayers and financial love offerings.

#### ROMANIA

I recently returned from South Eastern Europe (Romania) where I assisted Bishop DeHart, of Heartland Church in Irving, TX, conduct a **national pastor's conference**. God moved in a marvelous way as we trained these newly freed pastors. **Romania has been under a communist regime for decades**. The people gained their freedom as recently as the 1990's. Under this extreme tyranny was the possibility of the death penalty for preaching the gospel. Now the people are slowly rising out of their terrible conditions but **there are still cities of 50,000 or more with no churches**. Muslims largely populate these Romanian cities. Many of the pastors were severely persecuted for their faith. I was greatly blessed and humbled to minister to these extraordinary men and women of God. **The power and anointing of the Lord fell on all of us as we prayed for one another.**



#### HONDURAS

As you read this letter I am in the Honduras helping conduct an **evangelistic crusade, a medical clinic and dedicate a new water well**. As you well know, fresh, pure water is essential for life. The water in this region of the world is extremely contaminated and dangerous. In some areas in Central America where we work, **infant death rate is as high as 40%**. This translates to four out of every ten babies die simply because of the bad water. When we supply safe water and medical help for these people, practically every person accepts Christ as their Lord and Savior. They understand that they have no chance of a better life without Jesus. Since our primary purpose is to bring these precious people the **Living Water** of Jesus Christ, **we also plan to build a church in all the communities** that do not have one.

#### PERU

**We recently installed fresh water systems** in villages in the Amazon jungle where we have previously built churches. The native people came from miles around to see and taste the pure water. Many people were saved as the gospel was preached at the church where we installed one of the systems. As I stated last month, these water systems cost **\$700.00** each. Through your prayers and support we can continue to supply the funds to provide many villages with pure water.

#### THANK YOU

I know I can do some of these activities on my own, but **you** make it possible for us to do something **very** significant for Jesus. Your contribution through prayer, mission trips and giving, **enables our teams to make a real impact on the areas in which we work. You are vitally important to this ministry.** We cannot perform the tasks God has set before us without you. As the scripture says would happen ...

*"...and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God. For the service that the ministering of this fund renders does not only fully supply what is lacking to the saints, but it also overflows in many [cries of] thanksgiving to God... they will glorify God for your loyalty and obedience to the Gospel of Christ which you confess, as well as for your generous-hearted liberality to them and to all [the other needy ones]."*  
(2 Corinthians 9:11-13 Amp.)

...these wonderful, remote people constantly express their love and appreciation for your continued support. They also realize their ability to obtain church buildings, medical clinics, orphanages, schools and fresh water systems is impossible without your gifts of kindness. **You** make all of these things possible.

Thank you again for your prayers. **Prayer is the most vital thing you can do** for our ministry, yet without finances we also cannot do these '*acts of kindness*'. We truly know that God hears your intercession on our behalf. We love you with the love of the Lord.
